Description: The workshop will focus on how driver education teachers can use materials developed by ADTSEA on tire safety and maintenance and how to incorporate the training module within the ADTSEA 3.0 Driver Education Curriculum. Participants of the workshop will receive a complimentary copy of the ADTSEA 3.0 Curriculum, which includes lesson plans, learning activities, visuals and videos and a copy of the Michelin/ADTSEA Tire Safety Lesson Plan at no charge.

There will be a demonstration of the tire safety and maintenance unit, developed by ADTSEA and hands-on activities.
