

Historic **OLD TOWN AUBURN**

Where History Captures Your Heart



Auburn is situated in the Northern California foothills of the Sierra Nevada range close to the American River. The town is known for its rich California Gold Rush history and is registered as a California Historical Landmark. Originally established as a gold mining camp, the restored Old Town has houses and retail buildings from the middle of the 19th century. The oldest fire station and the Post Office date from the Gold Rush years.
