

Spouse/Family Outing, Forest Park Tour (Tuesday, July 27th - 10 am-3 pm)

The world traveled to St. Louis for the Louisiana Purchase Exposition, more commonly referred to as the 1904 Worlds Fair. The 1,300-acre park has recently undergone a massive restoration program. Transportation will be available to take you to various attractions in the park.

- The **Saint Louis Art Museum** served as the Fine Arts Palace during the Fair, and it was the only permanent exhibit building built for the fair. Admission-Free
- Another spectacular Fair "leftover" is massive walk-through birdcage that served as the Smithsonian Flight Cage can be found at the world famous **Saint Louis Zoo!** Admission-Free
- At the **Missouri History Museum**, visit an exhibit of artifacts from the Fair called "The 1904 Worlds Fair: Looking Back at Looking Forward-Admission-Free
- Try exploring the 700+ exhibits at the **St. Louis Science Center-Free**

Lunch is on your own and available in all of the above venues. You may also eat at the Boathouse where paddleboats are available.

The Frenchtown area, known for its antique shopping, boasts 58 historic French Colonial and German buildings.
