ABSTRACT

Teens are using marijuana on a regular basis. The trend in 12th grade use across the U.S. was up to 22% use in the past month. Emergency room mentions have increased by thousands. In 2007 – 2012, Colorado traffic fatalities, where the driver tested positive for marijuana, increased 100% (Rocky Mountain HIDTA). How does marijuana impact the adolescent brain? What are the risks to adolescents and driving? How does prevention and treatment work for teens?
